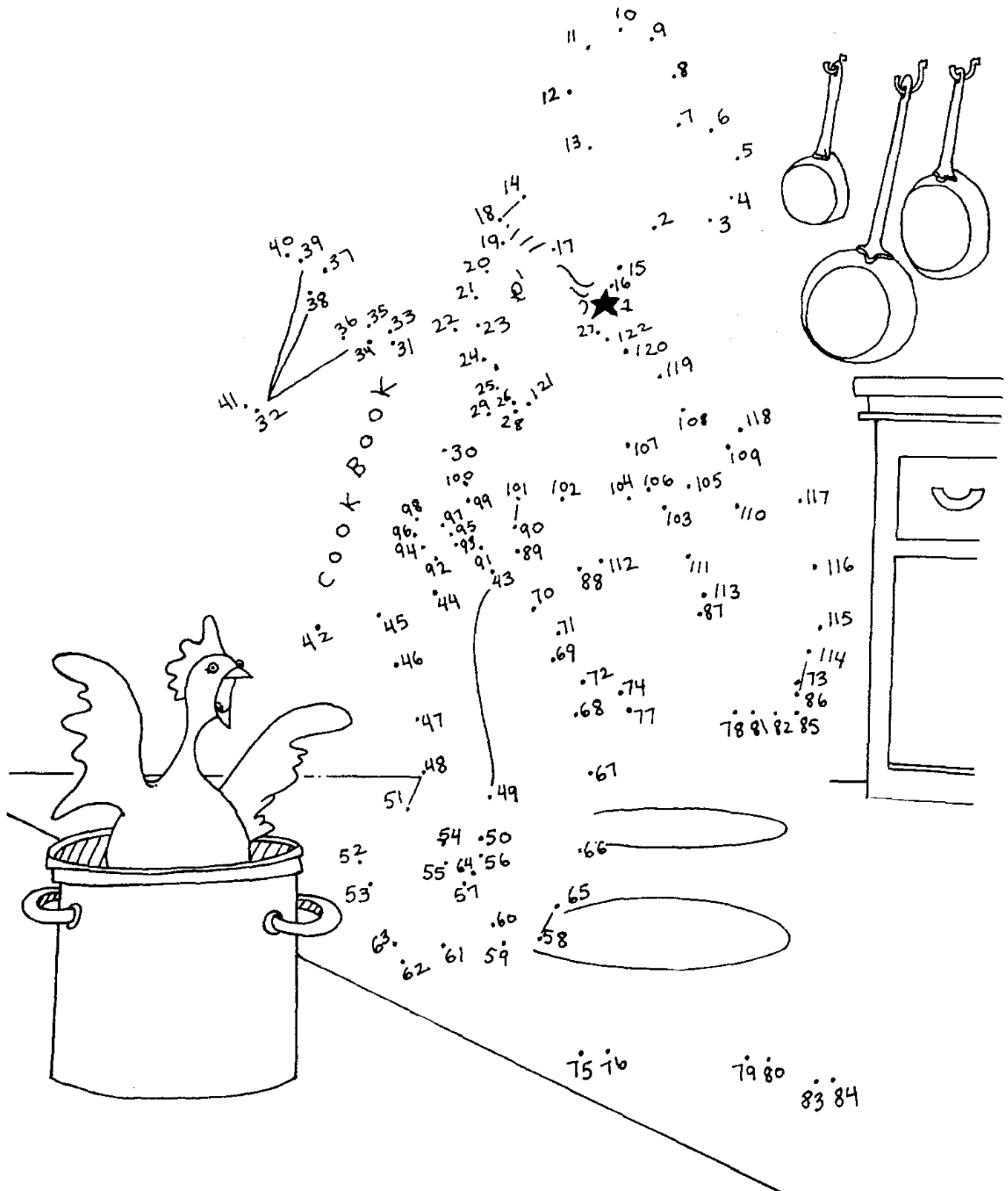

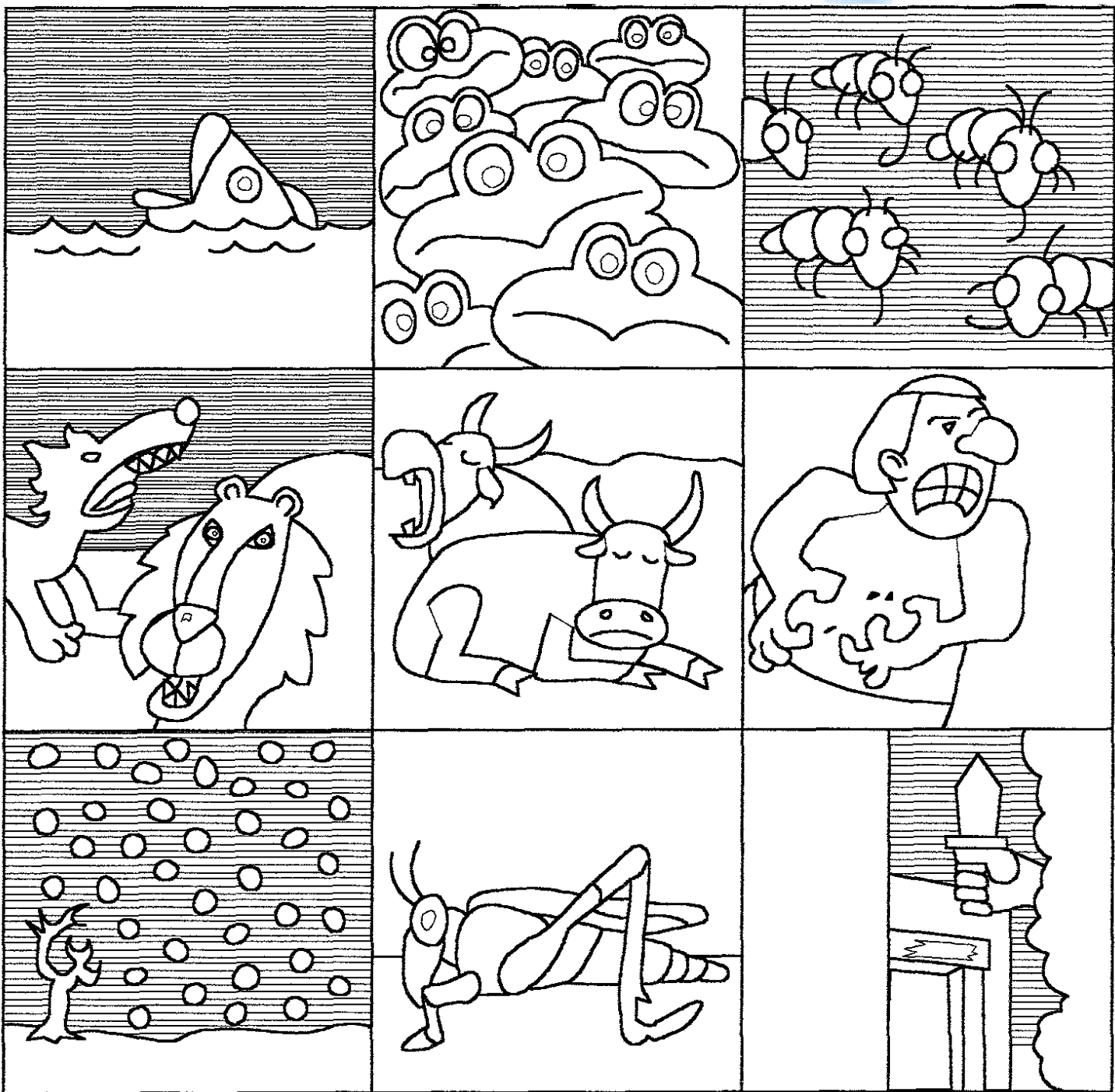

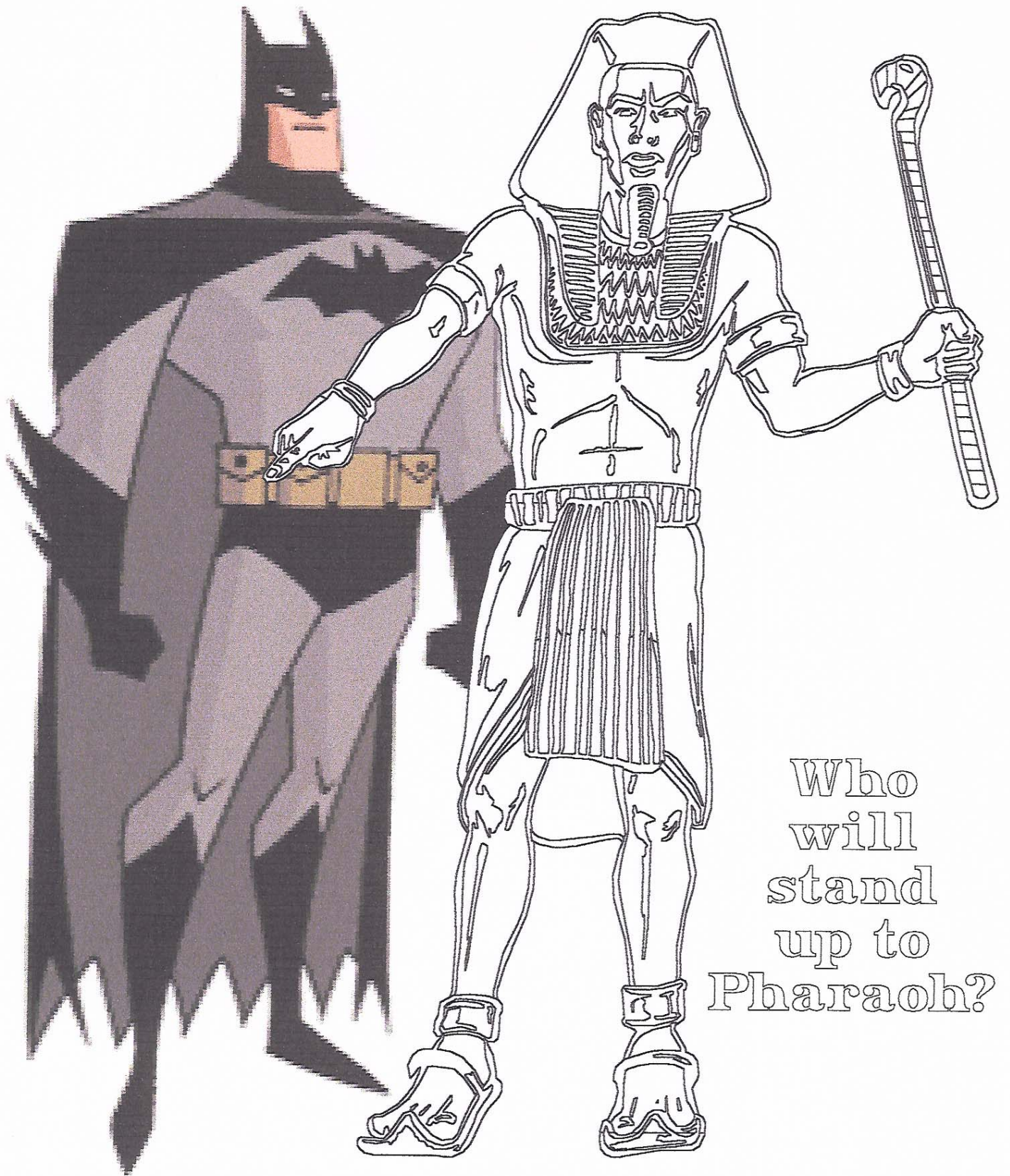
CHICKEN IN HOT WATER

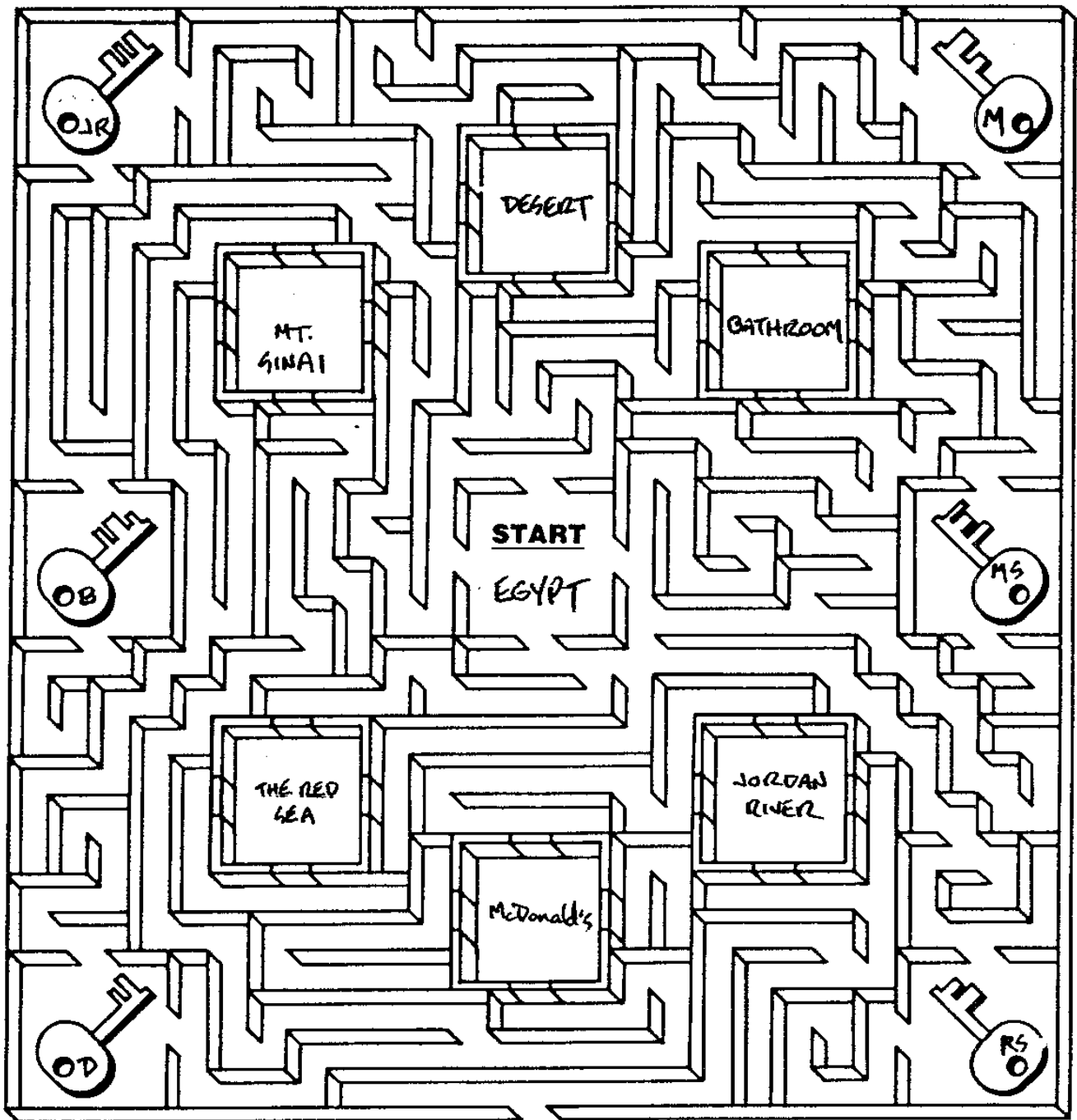


WHAT'S ON THE SEDER PLATE?

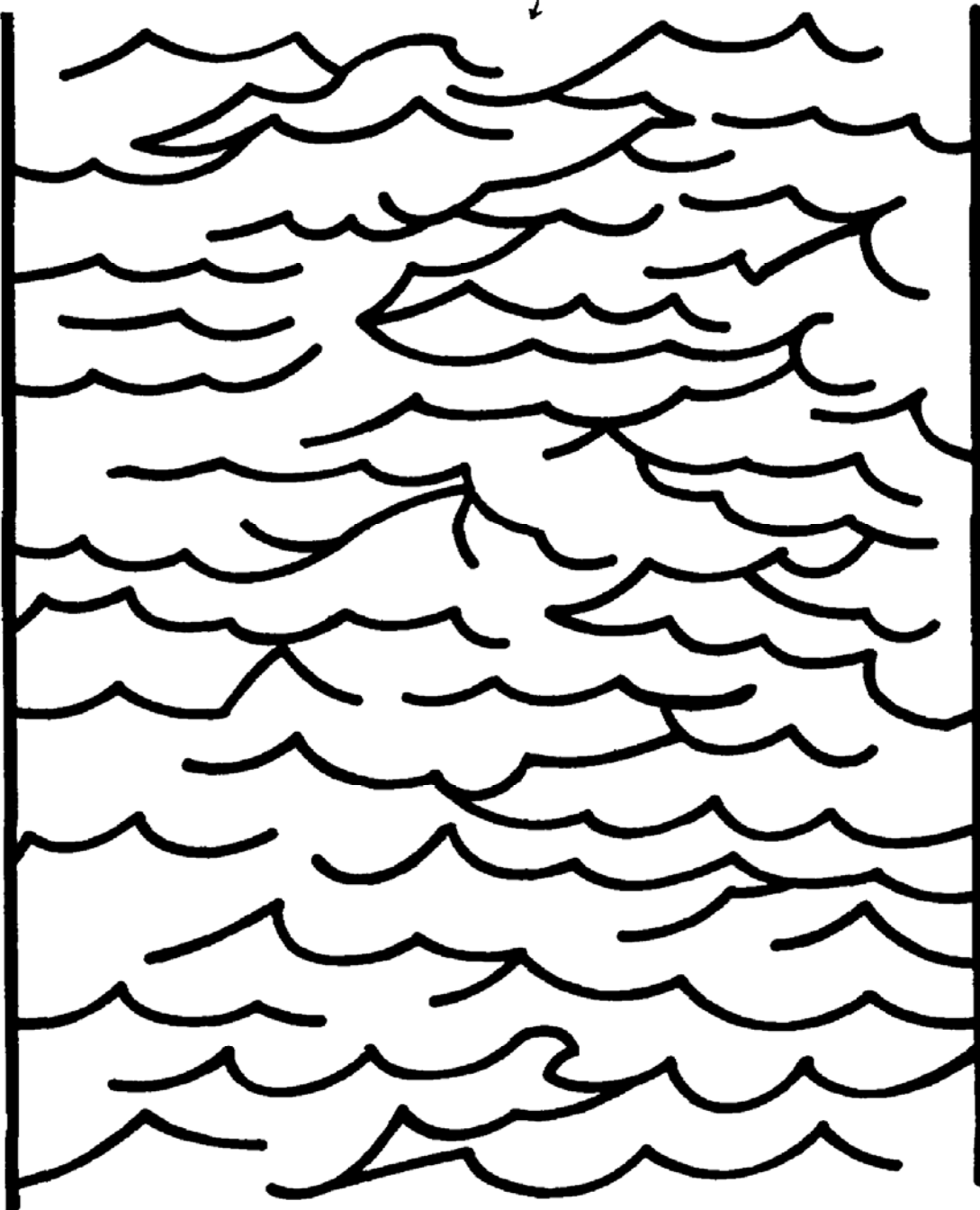
JAMMED-UP JEWISH PESACH JOURNEY

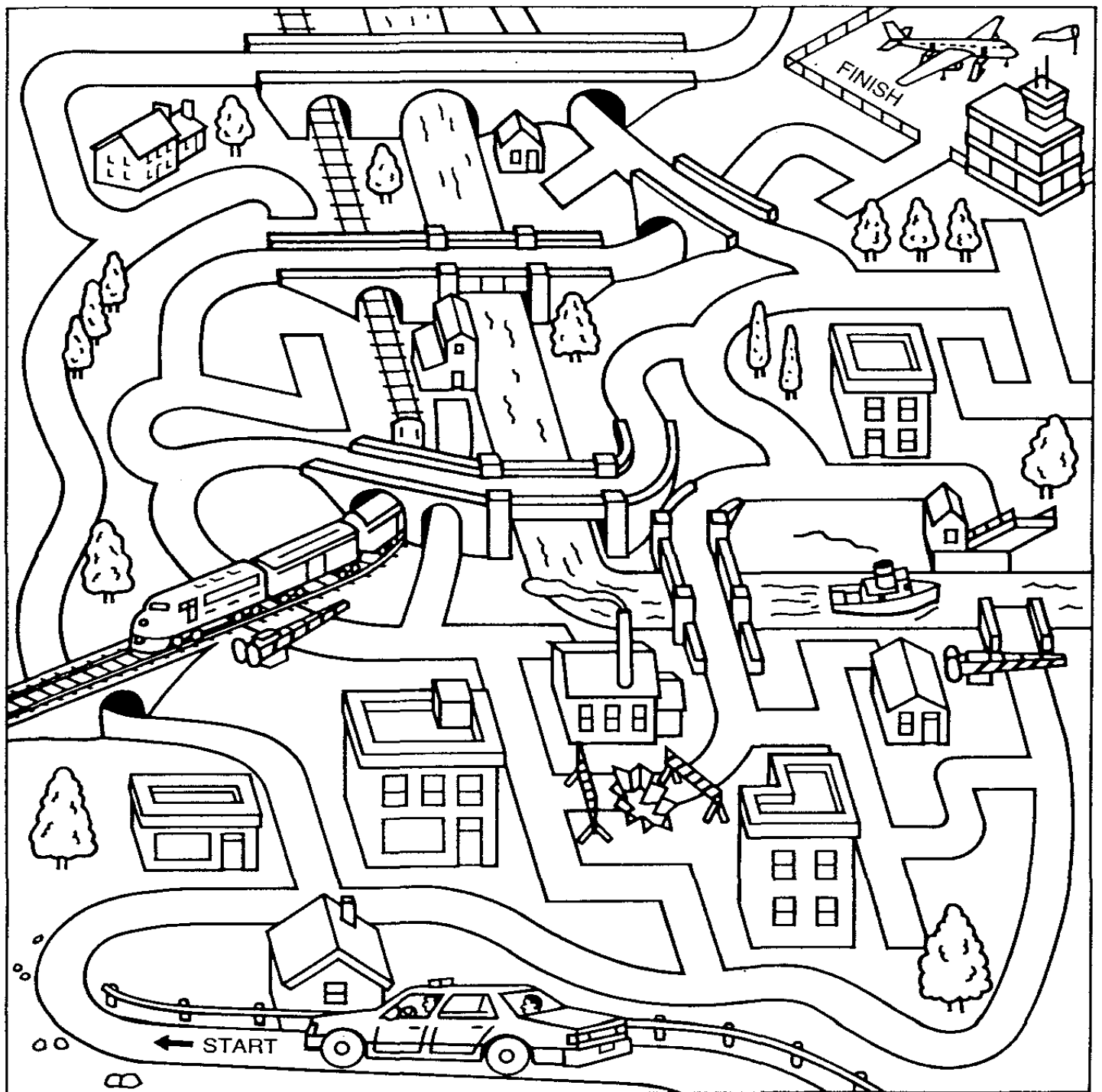

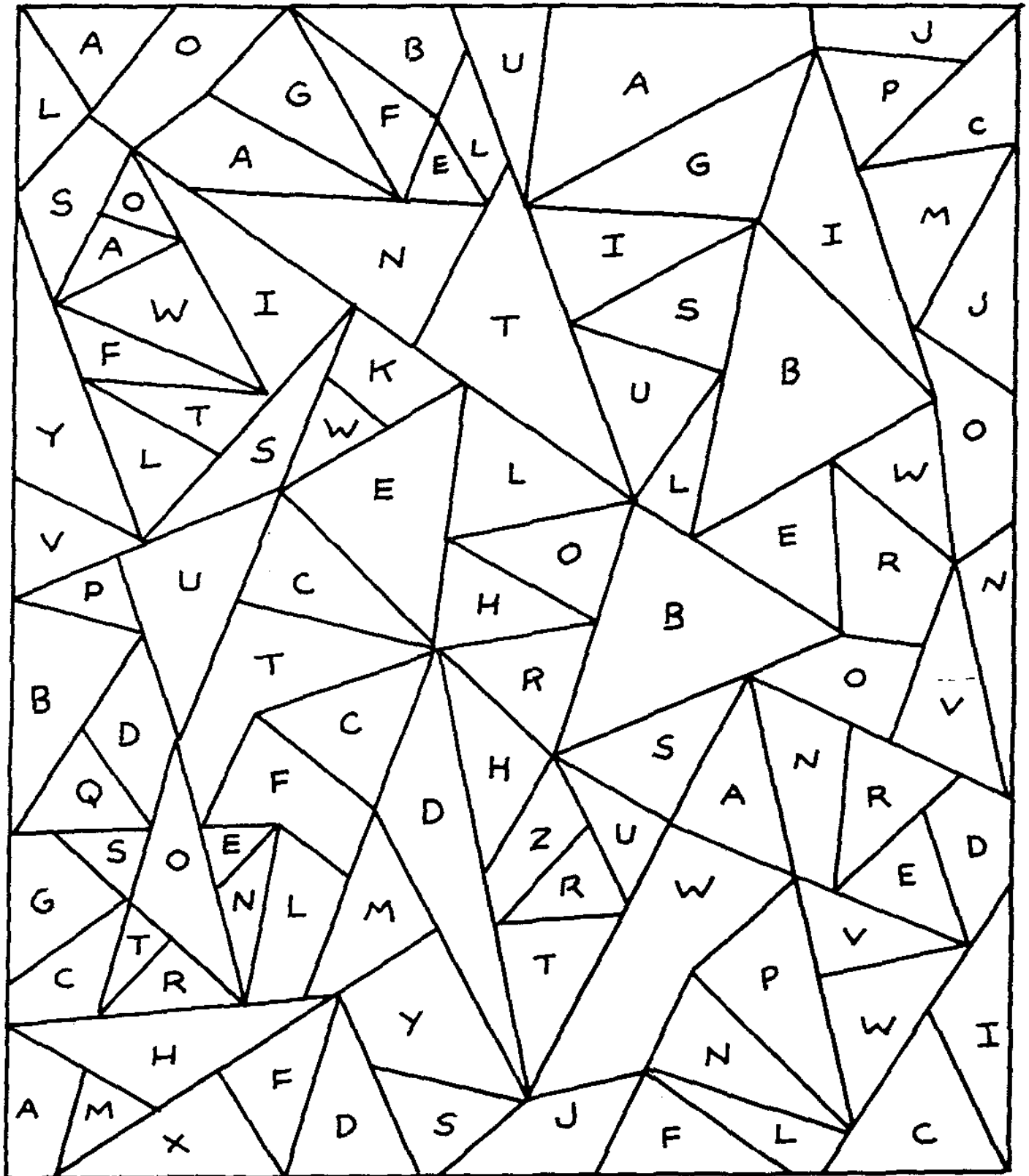
Wandering in the Desert

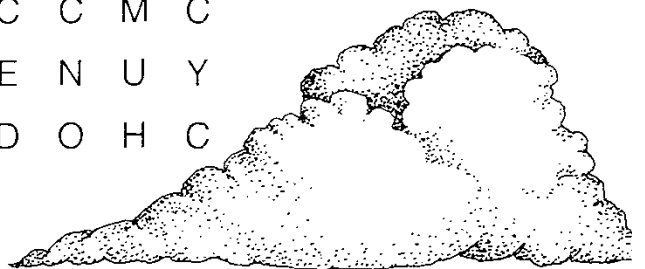
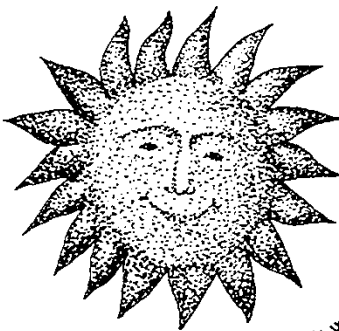

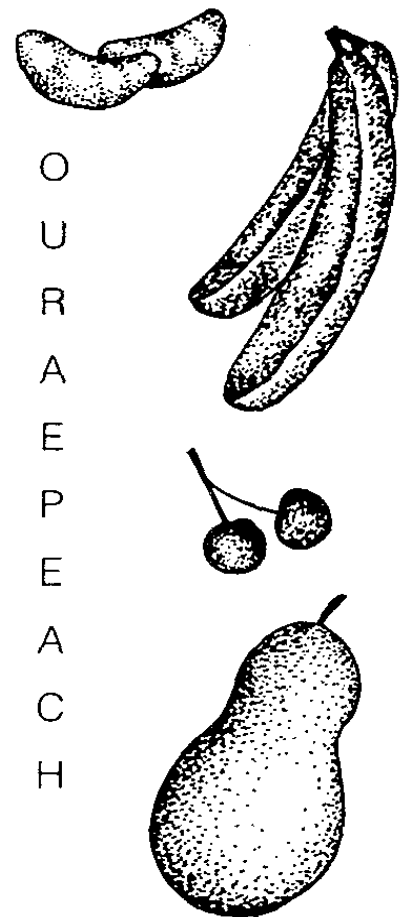
